

Notice of a COVID-19 Outbreak at School

Dear Families,

The purpose of this letter is to inform you that KFL&A Public Health has **declared an outbreak of COVID-19 at Truedell Public School** following the identification of a second positive case in a student from the same cohort. This new case was already isolating so there is no new impact to the school community. There are now a total of three cases at the school, only two are linked to the outbreak. The school remains open, however, visitors are limited at this time.

As per provincial Ministry of Health and Ministry of Education guidance, an outbreak is declared in a school once it has been determined that two individuals have tested positive for COVID-19 with an epidemiological link (meaning these students/staff could have become infected with COVID-19 at school, either from each other or a common source), within a 14-day period. This could include transportation. Affected cohorts receive separate letters where required.

Families are asked to continue to monitor for symptoms of COVID-19 and screen all students daily as most cases of COVID-19 are acquired in the home setting. KFL&A Public Health is also asking families to use the [extended symptom list for monitoring symptoms](#).
